NUT free zone

As previously advised we have a child with a confirmed nut allergy in school. To avoid any risk of contamination or contact in the school setting we request that all parents adhere to the "nut free zone" rule. Please bear this in mind particularly with cereal bars and sandwich fillings (eg: chocolate spread (Nutella) and peanut butter).



School Clubs

Clubs will resume week commencing 15th January. Cornwall Music's drum lessons restart this Thursday, 11th January and keyboard lessons restart on Monday 15th. If you haven't signed up to Cornwall Music's direct billing, Autumn term music tuition bills will be sent home shortly.

School Swimming Lessons: each Wednesday: Yellow Class

Children will have 10 consecutive lessons starting next Wednesday - 17th January. Children will be in the pool for the duration of the 45 min lesson but split according to ability. Children need swimming costume & towel (goggles are optional but a swim hat is required to be worn if your child has long hair). We do have a small stock of swim hats and goggles if needed. A contribution of £3.00 per child per lesson is requested which can be paid weekly or in total (£30.00). Children are permitted to wear a tracksuit (navy) on swim days for ease of changing or school uniform. We regret that due to ever tightening budgets that children absent from a lesson will still need to cover the cost and would request that everyone pays a contribution.

Universal free infant school meals

All Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are entitled to receive a free school meal automatically. Chartwells will cater for all children whatever their dietary needs: if your child needs the menu adapted eg: lactose free, no dairy etc please let the school office know asap so that arrangements can be made.



Whilst all Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 children receive a free meal automatically, any parent (from Years R to 6) meeting the criteria detailed should apply to Cornwall Council to apply for pupil premium. If you receive any of the following you may qualify:

- Income Support (IS)
- Income-Based jobseeker's allowance (not contribution based)
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (not contribution based)
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an Annual income of no more than £16,190.
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit (GPC)
- Support via Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA)
- Universal Credit

Please note, if you are in receipt of working tax credit, you do not qualify.

For further information or to check your eligibility go to www.cornwall.gov.uk (in the search box type free school meals). Claims cannot be backdated. There are also links under "useful links" (important info tab) on our school website.
